Notes 2018 due 15 July 2039 issued by the Issuer on 24 October 2018 as Series No. 1374, which Notes formed the subject matter of a Final Terms dated 22 October 2018, (ii) the EUR 25,000,000 1.500 per cent. Notes 2020 due 15 July 2039 issued by the Issuer on 4 May 2020 as Series No. 1484, which Notes formed the subject matter of a Final Terms dated 30 April 2020, (iii) the EUR 50,000,000 1.500 per cent. Notes 2022 due 15 July 2039 issued by the Issuer on 7 February 2022 as Series No. 1566, which Notes formed the subject matter of a Final Terms dated 3 February 2022, (iv) the EUR 275,000,000 1.500 per cent. Notes 2022 due 15 July 2039 issued by the Issuer on 16 March 2022 as Series No. 1574, which Notes formed the subject matter of a Final Terms dated 14 March 2022 and (v) the EUR 75,000,000 1.500 per cent.
