FINAL TERMS

The Notes will, on the Issue Date (as defined herein), be consolidated and become fungible and form a single Series with the existing GBP 325,000,000 2.000 per cent. Notes 2022 due 12 April 2024 issued by the Issuer on 12 April 2022 as Series No. 1577, which Notes formed the subject matter of a Final Terms dated 8 April 2022, the existing GBP 25,000,000 2.000 per cent. Notes 2022 due 12 April 2024 issued by the Issuer on 21 April 2022 as Series No.1581, which Notes formed the subject matter of a Final Terms dated 19 April 2022, the existing GBP 150,000,000 2.000 per cent. Notes 2022 due 12 April 2024 issued by the Issuer on 25 April 2022 as Series No. 1585, which Notes formed the subject matter of a Final Terms dated 21 April 2022 and the existing GBP 50,000,000 2.000 per cent Notes 2022 due 12 April 2024 issued by the Issuer on 18 July 2022 as Series No. 1593, which Notes formed the subject matter of a Final Terms dated 14 July 2022 (the "Original Notes").
